Diane G. distributed summaries of both host and user surveys. Members discussed the overall results as well as the individual comments. As several respondents were not aware of how to search for kits with large print, Claudia suggested that she speak to Steve about listing titles with LP on website. It was also noted that there was a criticism of not having disclaimers or citations on the discussion questions. We will attempt to add disclaimers to them. Claudia suggested we try to have a block of time at the conference for host libraries to allow them to discuss procedures as a group. It was also suggested that we try to get on the agenda for the fall READS in order to give an overall report to the membership.

Diane M. said the website was having problems with being kept up to date and we should consider promoting the kits on NHAIS on an ongoing basis, likely monthly. It was thought we could promote some of the titles not circulating as well.

The balance of the meeting was spent discussing possible future titles, as it has become apparent that the program will need more kits fairly soon. Some titles being considered: Those who save us; The Woods; Garden spells; Saffron kitchen; Skeletons at the feast; Tenderness of wolves. At this point, not all titles are available in paper or LP.
