LUNCHEON SPEAKERS

A buffet lunch, included in your registration fee, is scheduled for each day and we have booked two very exciting speakers. Jean was recently recognized as one of ten librarians nationally to receive the 2008 Carnegie Corporation/New York Times *I Love My Librarian* award. Wednesday's speaker is John Blyberg, the Assistant Director for Innovation and User Experience at the Darien Library in Connecticut. John was named one of Library Journal's *Movers*

and *Shakers* in 2006 and he has authored a number of open source projects, including SOPAC, Locum, and Insurge, a social catalog suite that allows libraries to focus holistically on digital strategy.
